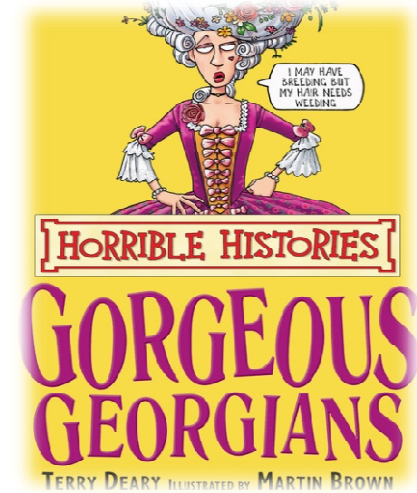

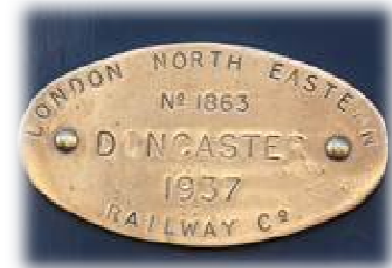
Mallard Festival of Speed

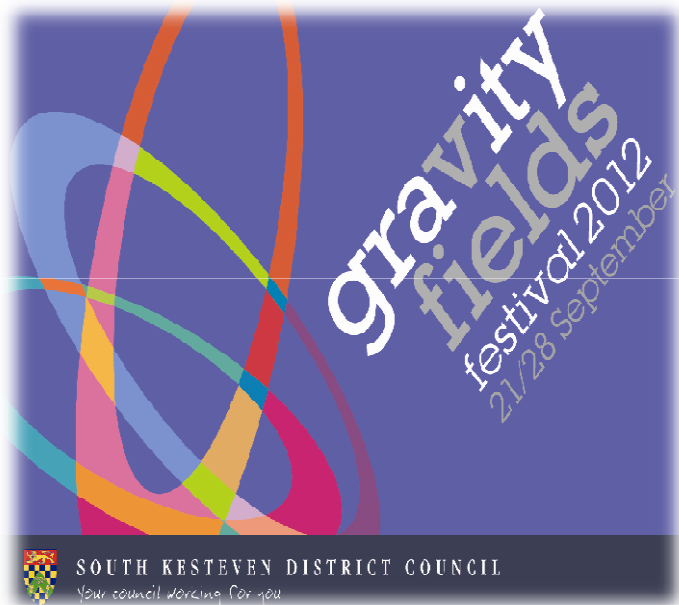
