1. INTRODUCTION

The application is for a Club Registration Certificate under the Licensing Act 2003. The application is attached at Appendix 1, together with a location map.

The Licensing Act 2003 transfers responsibility for the licensing of the supply and sale of alcohol from the Magistrates Courts to the local authority.

The applicant needs to follow a set procedure that includes consultation with interested parties, who are able to address the application that has been applied for. If an interested party makes a representation objecting to the grant of a licence, the matter will be determined by the Alcohol and Entertainment Licensing Committee.

Newage Sports and Social Club hold a Club Registration Certificate that remains in force until 24th November 2005.

The Council received two letters of representations from interested parties that were received within the 28 day limit. The letters of representation are attached as Appendix 2.

That the Committee determines, with regard to the licensing objectives, the application concerning the grant of a club registration certificate that has been requested.

The four licensing objectives of prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm, have been addressed in the application.


