## Background

1. I enclose information provided by Lincolnshire Police Authority concerning the consultation process on the proposed merger of East Midlands police forces.

As part of this consultation process, a public meeting is being held in the Guildhall Arts Centre on Tuesday 11th July and all members have been made aware of this through my weekly e-mail.

## Timetable

2. Police Authorities have until 11th August 2006 to submit any objections to the proposed merger and they have asked for their consultation form to be submitted and returned to them by 7th July. As this date is before the public meeting in Grantham and as I imagine that the Cabinet will want to take cognisance of the outcome from this meeting before responding, I have informed the Police Authority that feedback from South Kesteven will not be available until after the 11th July.

### Recommendation

3. In view of this restricted timetable, I would recommend that the Cabinet delegate to Councillor Linda Neal as portfolio holder authority to submit a representation from the Council to the Police authority after the public meeting on the 11th July.
