8. Highways.

a) Drains –

i) New Estate.

The drain outside No7 New estate very badly blocked. The assertion by the County Council that this is a soak-away drain is not agreed with as the water is currently a foot deep and has obviously not 'soaked away'.

ii) 15 High Street

The drain on the corner of Creeton Road and 15 High Street is currently blocked.

b) Pot Holes

Park Road

Pot holes between No 4 Park Road and the junction with Bourne Road and High Street have worsened and now need urgent attention.

9. Councillors' Reports

a) Dangerous Wall

The limestone on the low wall adjacent to Bus Shelter on the High Street is very badly perished and urgently in need of replacement and pointing. It is especially dangerous as it abuts the green on which children play regularly

b) Jubilee Community Orchard

It was agreed that Cllr. Lunn to negotiate the mowing contract for this year.

c) Replacement of Seat – Croake Hill

It was agreed to purchase a replacement seat for siting at the bottom of Croake Hill – Cllr. Webb to progress this.

d) Notice Board.

It was agreed that unless remedial work was undertaken to the Notice Board, the wood would become rotten and further costs would be incurred in funding a replacement. It was agreed that restoration work would be undertaken. Cllr. Lunn is to progress this.
