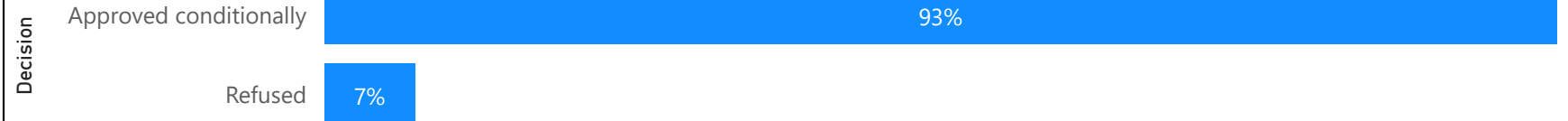

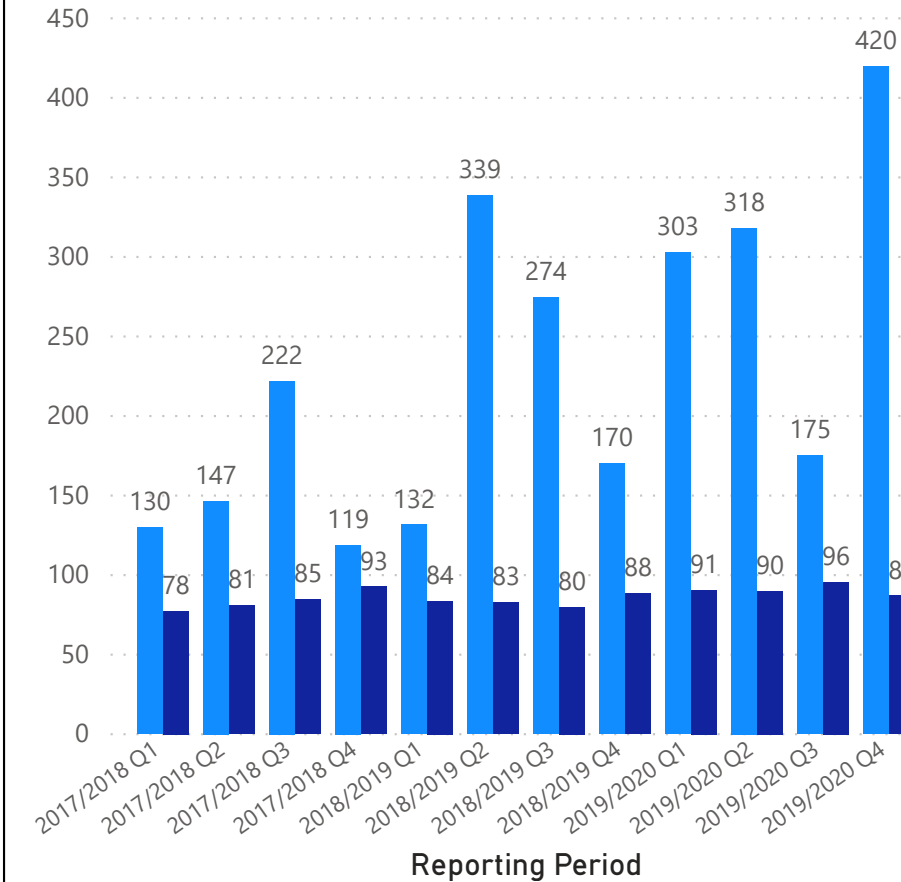

Commentary/Implications

Processing of Planning Applications

Over 2019-20, 89% of majors were determined within time against the national target of 60%.

Minor applications cumulative figure for the year to date remains slightly above the target of 65% with 67% of minor application determined in time.

Other applications performance for the year to date at 78.6% falls below the national target of 80% of applications determined within time.

Average Days of Determination

Performance on major applications can vary significantly due to the relatively smaller number of major applications and the highly variable length of time it might take to determine them. The number of days taken to determine majors in quarter 4 is high due to the nature of applications that were determined. Average time to determine non-major applications has reduced slightly to 87 days as new staff develop the necessary skills and knowledge, it is likely to remain high over the rest of the year due to staff inexperience.
