My concerns are:

The supply of alcohol from Friday to Sunday from 10:00 -00:30

The provision of live music from Monday-Sunday 18:00- 23:30

Late night refreshment Friday-Sunday 23:00-00:30

My objection is based mainly on the concern that this new license may increase the possibility of public nuisance for the many people living in the dwellings nearby.

To get to Sedgebrook, a very small, isolated village, personal vehicle transport is essential, unless local taxi services are used.

I am concerned about the noise nuisance caused by patrons entering and leaving the event by either taxi or personal transport. The personal transport option has to raise a concern for public safety, whereby if the premises are licensed, it will encourage patrons to use their own vehicles to enter and leave the premises until past midnight, after the consumption of alcohol.

Other concerns are, as car parking is limited at the venue and patrons only option will be to park on School Lane, this will bring extra noise for dwellings in the area, as patrons enter and leave the premises.

Live music every night 18:00-23:30 will also increase the possibility of public nuisance to the people living nearby, especially on summer evenings when doors and windows of the premises will undoubtedly be open.

As this nuisance will happen on a daily basis, I have to raise a representation against it unless there is a clause attached to the license, restricting the number of events per year.

Additionally, depending on the nature of events, I would be concerned about the possibility of an increase in low level disorder when guests are leaving.

I would be grateful if the licensing team would consider my objection.
