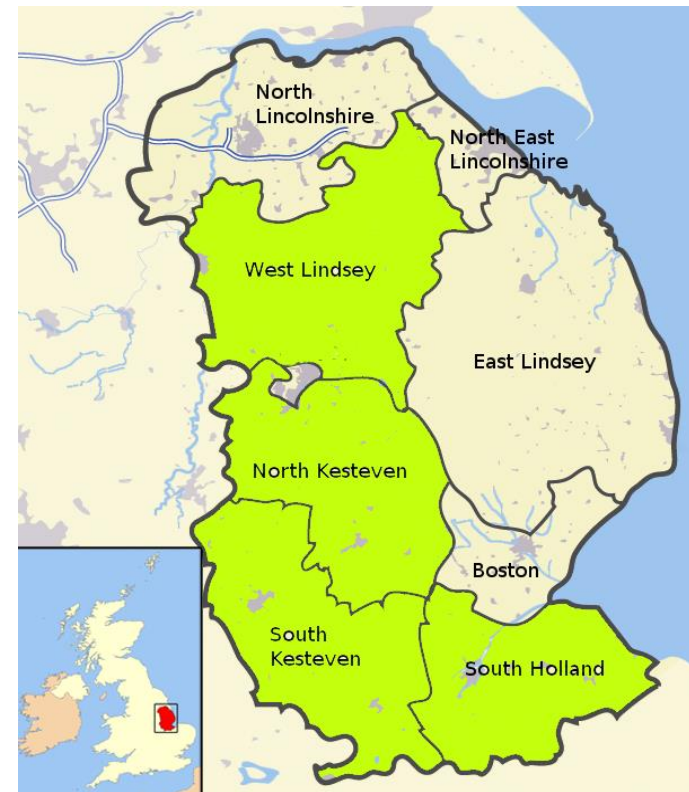

---

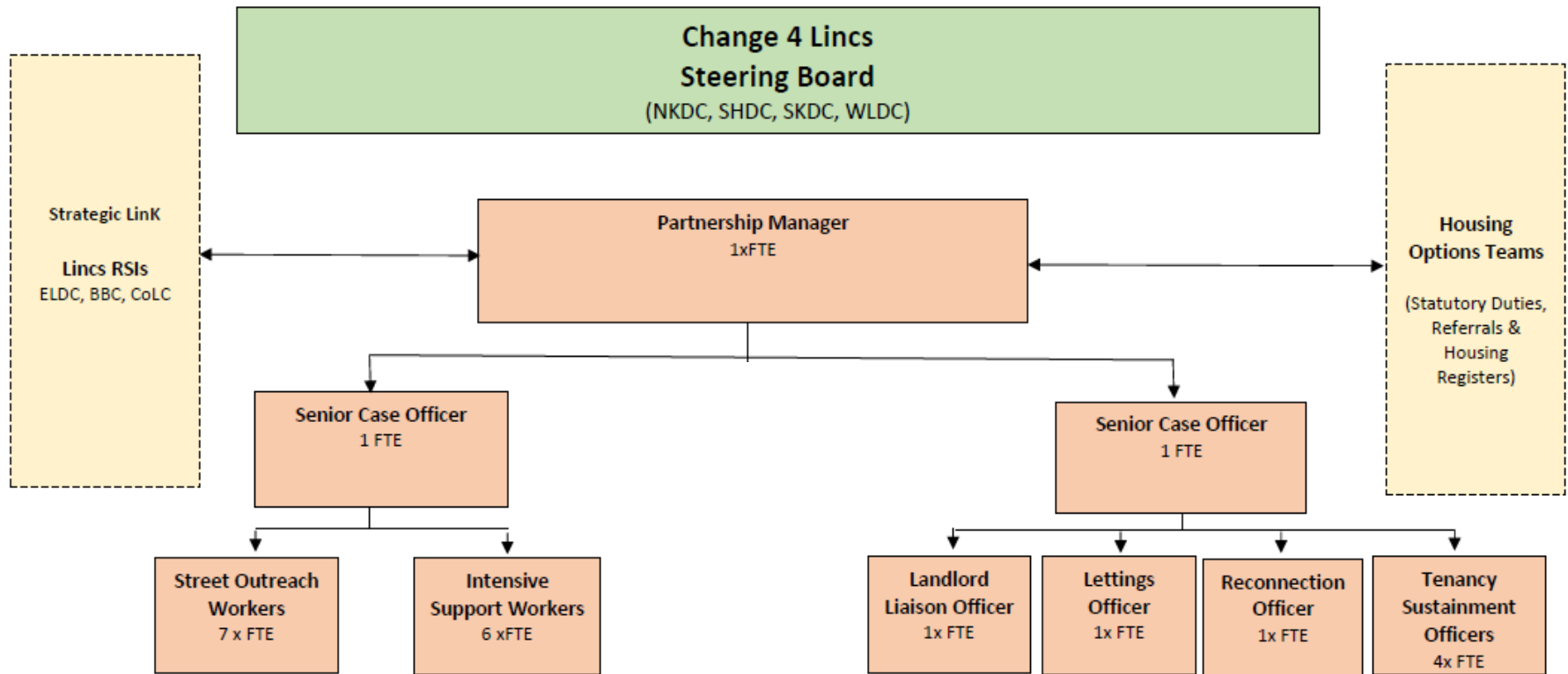
- Prevention
