				<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The project aims to help individuals with health-related barriers to access skills training and support;• Steadfast has identified a gap in support for JCP claimants between month 3 and 6 of their claim;• The service will identify local job vacancies and match participants' skills with relevant job opportunities;• All training provided will improve job seekers' skills and meet the needs of local employers;• The service will provide follow-on in-work support and ongoing on-the-job-training/short courses and mentoring to individuals to help them sustain employment;• The 13-week programme consists of a 1-2-1 In-Depth Assessment (IDA) followed by personalised health and wellbeing-focused coaching and mentoring delivered by a Personal Advisor or a Community Connector.• Amongst other outputs/outcomes, the proposed programme will support a total of 105 participants with employability and skills support and mentoring, 90 of which will complete the full 13-week programme and achieve at least one labour market relevant qualification. A minimum of 36 participants will progress into work or self-employment.

SK-2142	Wyndham Park Forum	Grantham	£19,166.65	To host Wyndham 100 - a three day public event to celebrate an important town milestone; the Centenary of Wyndham Park, opened in July 1924. There will be evening concerts, as well as musical entertainment during the day. There will also be craft stalls over both days and there will be a range of children's activities including age-appropriate trails and activities. An historical display will focus on the history of Wyndham Park and the role played by the Machine Gun Corps. The event will reinforce Wyndham Park's Green Flag status

Separate new build of toilet/shower block. The current building has stood for 25 years and requires upgrading of heating, lighting, insulation and some fittings. We have suffered badly from flood damage recently and this seems the right time to make the building flood safe and update at the same time
SK-2148	Swayfield Village Hall	Swayfield	£25,000	Swayfield Village Hall wishes to install solar panels on the roof of the hall in order to provide a renewable energy solution, reduce its energy costs and reduce its carbon footprint. The hall is totally reliant on electricity for its central heating and hot water and consequently has seen a huge rise in running costs over the last year. Increases in charges have been made to users of the hall but any further increases cannot be absorbed by these groups.
SK-2150	The Aveland History Group	Folkingham	£12,000	We are planning a two-day family friendly free event on 14th/15th September 2024 as part of Lincolnshire Heritage Open Days in the village of Folkingham. The event will honour our Allies who flew in great numbers for both Operation Overlord in June 1944 and this later mission. A range of enactors, exhibitors, lecturers, educationalists, entertainers and traders will come from across the country. With free entry, the event will attract families with kids of all ages, as well as seniors wishing to reminisce and share memories.
SK-2151	Jubilee Church (ACM)	Grantham	£10,000	We urgently need to replace 3 of our air source heat pumps that are over 12 years old in two of our rooms, one is not working at present and is now limiting what we can offer. The existing units are not economical to run and frequently break down.

The car park is in a poor state of repair meaning many facility users are parking on the main road causing some congestion and narrowing of the highway.
