- 1.1 Approval of the name **The Warenne** in order to provide postal addresses for a residential development off Kettering Road Stamford – Ref: SNN/2024/0004.

- 2.1 Stamford Town Council had no objections with the developers with the suggestion of the name.

3 Available Options Considered

- 3.1 This is a development of 3 new dwellings being built on land off Kettering Road, Stamford which requires a new road name.
- 3.2 The road name was suggested regarding the history of Stamford associated with William De Warenne 5th Earl of Surrey.
