Summary of Decision to Be Taken:	<p>That Cabinet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Approves an immediate management fee payment of £150,000 to Leisure SK Ltd.2. Delegates to the Council's s151 Officer in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Finance and Economic Development to identify the most appropriate source of funding from which to make the payment. <p>Cabinet will consider the report at its meeting on 18 January 2024.</p>

Reason for Non-Deferral:	<p>The urgency is for financial reasons. Approval of the additional £150k management fee will ensure LeisureSK Limited can meet its cashflow requirements in January. The Council could choose not to approve the increased management fee request. However, this would mean LeisureSK Limited would not be able to meet its cashflow requirements which would result in centres facing closure.</p> <p>Chairman of the Council are content that the decision is urgent and that the decision can be exempt from call-in.</p>
