Steadfast Training Ltd	The 'Connect2Grow' project proposed to provide a locally integrated skills and employment service that tackled deep-seated barriers to work.	£51,500
Lincolnshire Drizzle Company	The project was seeking to increase the company's productivity and increase markets which would provide new jobs	£20,00
West Deeping Village Hall	New Flat Roof above Kitchen and refitted Kitchen with appliances. The Roof Leaks in kitchen and can cause problems to hirers and desperately needs reroofing.	£17,000
Claypole Village Hall	A funding request had been received from Claypole Village Hall in respect of the resurfacing of the car park at the village hall to address several issues. The current surface hindered accessibility for those with mobility challenges and regular repairs were not helping with standing water which also compromised safety.	£23,800
South Kesteven District Council	The funding request from South Kesteven District Council was to help facilitate the implementation of district-wide biodiversity-focused projects to develop and enhance green space. This would incorporate a predominant focus on community rewilding initiatives. The funding would be distributed between meaningful projects in the vicinities of Grantham, Stamford, Bourne and Market Deeping. Feasibility studies would be conducted in areas of ecological interest.	£40,000



Barkston and Syston Playing field	This is a refurbishment of showers and flooring of the Changing Rooms, toilets, and meeting areas.	£6,000
Barrowby Parish Council	The project aims to install lighting along the pathway from Low Road to the Pavilion, currently there are no lights, and the area is quite rural, making it unsafe for users entering Low fields by foot from the main village road to gain access to the fields and Pavilion.	£10,000
Deeping Men in Sheds	Men's Sheds are fantastic community spaces that promote well-being, camaraderie, and skill-sharing among men. They provide a supportive environment where men can work on projects, learn new skills, and socialize.	£20,000
Pointon & Sempringham Parish Council	The project for the replacement of play equipment on the playing field that was currently 50 years old and unsafe for the growing population of the children living within the parish.	£23,676.17
Foston Village Hall	The project focuses on the renewal of part of the village hall flooring. The current floor tiles in the entrance hall, bar area, seating area and kitchen are old, cracked and lifting away from the base surface. In places, this provides a trip hazard. Likewise, the carpeted area in the ante-room is old, and poorly fitted	£8,617.35
