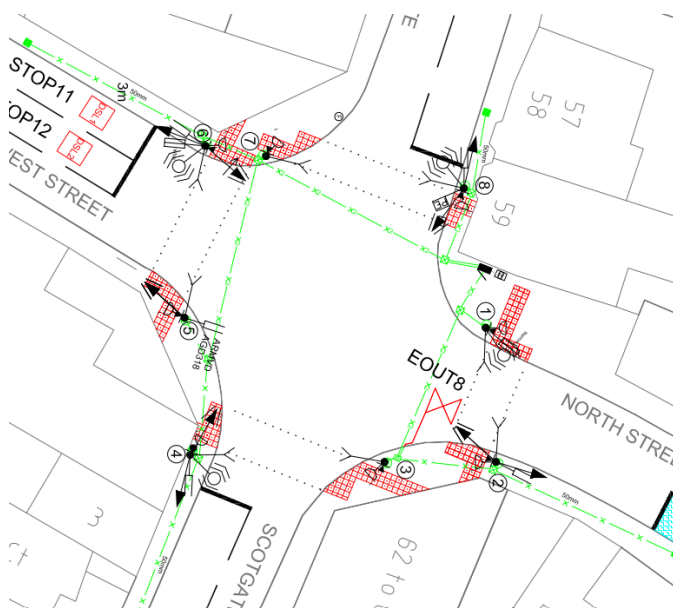
## **Legal and Governance**

## **2 The Purpose of the Report**

- 2.1 Lincolnshire County Council have requested funds totalling £56,812.00 towards the improvements to MOVA (microprocessor optimised vehicle actuation) at Scotgate traffic signal junction.
- 2.2 Works include provision of MOVA (traffic signals) control to include upgrade to traffic controller, new MOVA control unit, magnetometer detection, commissioning & validation as detailed in the plan below:



- 2.3 Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) has confirmed the total cost of works that were completed in 2016/17 totalled £69,727.25.

- 2.4 Due to there being a shortfall with the amount received by S106 contributions LCC has confirmed that it will be funding the remaining balance of £12,915.25 with the Traffic Signals Capital Refurbishment budget.
- 2.5 SKDC is in receipt of Section 106 contributions from S12/0864 a sum of £112,061.08 (£55,249.08 of this is for the provision of a temporary bus service serving the development of S12/0864).
- 2.6 The relevant clauses within the S106 agreements specify the money is for the following purpose S12/0864 – *The clause states on page 41 point 6, Traffic signal contribution: To be used towards the installation of a microprocessor optimised vehicle actuation (“MOVA”) system at Scotgate traffic signals junction.*
- 2.7 The proposed use of the S106 contribution to fund the delivery of the works complies with the terms of the planning obligation.

### **3. Available Options Considered**

- 3.1 No other projects or bids for the funds have currently been received, as stated in the terms of the S106 agreement on page 43 and 44, points 6 and 7: The contribution is to be paid to the County Council for the improvements specified.

### **5. Reasons for the Decision(s)**

- 2.8 The proposed project has been considered to meet the requirements of the S106 funding specified within the agreements S12/0864. No other competing projects or schemes have been submitted.
