



**Appendix 1: South Kesteven UK Shared Prosperity Programme:
Officer Delegated Decision**



Applicant	Location	Funding Ask	Brief description
South Kesteven District Council	Grantham	£56,500	Meres Stadium Floodlights: Following a programme of investment across the leisure portfolio to upgrade existing equipment to maximise energy savings, the opportunity has been identified to replace the current metal halide lanterns providing illumination in the Stadium to LEDs. This will result in a reduction of energy use for the site and therefore a reduction in carbon emissions reported in future years, helping to contribute to the Council's target of at least 30% by 2030.
South Kesteven District Council	Bourne / Stamford	£69,632	Pool Covers: A report reviewing energy efficiency opportunities was completed by Leisure Energy in 2023 highlighting projects for the Council to consider across the centres. One of the recommendations of the report is to consider the installation of new pool covers to all pools in the leisure centres. This would result in an overall reduction in heat demand for the centres, through decreased heating of the pool water, as well as reduced consumption of electricity via the pool hall air handling units. The installation of new pool covers will reduce energy consumption within the leisure centres and reduce utility costs for Leisure SK, helping to ensure the sustainability of the centre.
South Kesteven District Council	Grantham	£37,000	LED Lights, Meres Sports Hall: A report reviewing energy efficiency opportunities was completed by Leisure Energy in 2023 highlighting projects for the Council to consider across the centres. One of the opportunities presented is to upgrade the lighting within the main and small sports halls at Grantham Meres to energy efficient LEDs. This is recommended based on the energy efficiency improvement of around 50% by upgrading to LEDs as well as the long operating hours for the centre and current lack of automatic controls.
South Kesteven District Council	Grantham	£125,000	Photovoltaic installation, The Picture House: Installation of the original design allowed a provisional sum for a basic Solar Photovoltaic installation. This addition has allowed a much larger scheme to assist in offsetting, not only the electrical usage of the new Customer Service



			Centre, but the existing SKDC first floor office space, along with the provision of battery storage. This will provide a system of approximately 50kW. This will be split across the two floors: Ground Floor - Customer Services (1/3 of generation), and 1st Floor – SKDC Office (2/3 of generation). There will be an inverter feeding each location located in the existing first floor plant room.
South Kesteven District Council	District Wide	£3,860	Aqua Sacks: Aqua Sacks acquired by the Council for distribution to households for flood protection.
South Kesteven District Council	District Wide	£13,504	Tree planting: 68 trees and shrubs have been planted across the district in 8 different locations, 30 as replacements for previously planted trees which failed to establish and 38 trees in new planting locations. This planting contributes to the aims of the Council’s Tree and Woodland Strategy by increasing canopy cover, delivering biodiversity, social and economic benefits, and improving the districts climate resilience.
South Kesteven District Council	Grantham	£10,434	Harrowby Lane Playing Field: As a part of the overall project to bring the long disused Harrowby Lane Playing Field the Council committed to clearing the building out and erecting a security fence. A security fence has been erected to the front of building, where it is accessed by a new vehicular gate. Two other sides of the building have also been fenced in the fourth side being a fence shared with the Club’s ground.
