1 The Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 Approval of a new street name for the access road that leads to The Willows Thurlby – by the resident Ref: SNN/2025/0067.

2 Comments of Consultees

- 2.1 Thurlby Parish Council were consulted by the resident with their suggestion for the road name for this site.

3 Available Options Considered

- 3.1 The access road is directly off Swallow Hill Thurlby leading to The Willows.
- 3.2 There will now be two properties leading of this access, and the resident has asked for a new road name as the properties are difficult to locate by delivery and emergency services due to not being directly on Swallow Hill.
- 3.3 A suggestion of The Old Brick Yard was proposed as historically the site used to be a brick yard in the 1800's and used to manufacture bricks which are used in various buildings in the village .
- 3.4 The proposed name has been agreed by both the resident and the Parish Council and complies with SKDC's policy and guidance.
