Allocation of South Kesteven UK Shared Prosperity Funding and Grantham Special Expense Area (SEA) Reserve Funding

This Officer Delegated Decision (ODD) report seeks approval to release un-allocated funds from the South Kesteven UK Shared Prosperity Fund and the Grantham SEA reserve to construct a multi-use sports court in Dysart Park, Grantham.

Decision:	That a contract is awarded to KOMPAN Ltd to construct a multi-use games area court in Dysart Park, Grantham, using a combination of UK Shared Prosperity Funds and Grantham SEA reserve funds.

Details of delegation:	The Deputy Chief Executive and S151 Officer has the necessary delegation to release funds from the Grantham SEA Reserve and South Kesteven UK Shared Prosperity Funding. The Council's Contract Procedure Rules allow for contracts with a total value of up to £200,000 to be approved by the Director.

1. Implications

Taking into consideration implications relating to finance and procurement, legal and governance, risk and mitigation, health and safety, diversity and inclusion, safeguarding, staffing, community safety, mental health and wellbeing and the impact on the Council's declaration of a climate change emergency, the following implications have been identified:

Finance

- 1.1 KOMPAN Ltd have submitted a price of £35,411.32 + vat following the development of a specification and officers engaging with three suppliers.
- 1.2 The Council will fund this using £19,000 of un-allocated monies from the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, to improve green spaces in South Kesteven.
- 1.3 The balance of £16,411.32 will be funded from the Grantham SEA reserve.

- 1.4 Officers have developed a specification and sought three written quotations to ensure best value. This is compliant with the Council's Contract Procedure Rules.

2. The Purpose of the Report

- 2.1 To award a contract to KOMPAN Ltd to construct a multi-use games area court in Dysart Park, Grantham, which will provide opportunities for residents to play both football and basketball on a hard court surface and be more active.
- 2.2 This will be funded by £19,000 of un-allocated SPF monies and the balance of £16,411.32 from the Grantham SEA reserve.
- 2.3 All UK Shared Prosperity fund awards must be fully spent by 31 March 2026.

- 2.4 The Council has received three written quotations to provide a multi-use games area in line with the Council's Contract Procedure Rules. These have been reviewed, and a decision has been made to award the contract to KOMPAN Ltd.

3. Available Options Considered

- 3.1 Option 1 – Utilise £19,000 of un-allocated SPF monies with the balance of £16,411.32 released from the Grantham SEA Reserve to enable the construction of a multi-use games court at Dysart Park, Grantham.
- 3.2 Option 2 – Not to release the funding and do nothing. This has been discounted as Grantham currently has limited free access outdoor facilities such as basketball and football, with existing paid or private venues creating financial barriers for many residents.

4. Preferred Option

- 4.1 To award a contract to KOMPAN Ltd to construct a multi-use games court in Dysart Park, Grantham.

5. Reasons for the Decision(s)

- 5.1 Officers have sought three written quotations in line with the Council's Contract Procedure Rules. KOMPAN Ltd's quotation provides best value for money and assurance has been given that they are able to complete the project within the funding timescales.
