Reason for Urgency:	<p>The Cabinet is required to take decision related to local government reorganisation (LGR). The consultation response was not on the Cabinet Forward Plan in time to give 28 days' notice, therefore the use of a General Exception notice is required.</p> <p>The Chairman of the Finance and Economic Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been informed that the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be referred.</p> <p>The Chairman of the Council is content that the decision is urgent and that the decision can be exempt from call-in, as consultation response are required to be submitted by 26 March 2026.</p>
