PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026

This order is made by South Kesteven District Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely the construction of a new single storey timber framed three bay garage with solar panels on the south facing pitch of the roof, and installation of solar panels on the south facing pitch of the roof of an existing workshop building at The Manor House, 21 Church Street, Haconby, Lincolnshire, PE10 0UJ (Planning Reference S23/1945 refers).

BY THIS ORDER

1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order (“the schedule”) shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of South Kesteven District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.

3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which South Kesteven District Council certifies that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

(PART 1)

Description of Existing Path

In the Parish of Haconby

The whole width of Haconby Public Footpath 3 running from OSGR TF 1072 2535 (A) in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 84 metres to terminate at OSGR TF 1078 2529 (B). The total length of footpath diverted is approximately 84 metres as shown between Points A-B on annexed Plan No. 2025/019/HacPF3/A4 (27/08/2025).

(PART 2)

Description of New Path

In the Parish of Haconby

A public footpath at a varying width of 1.6-2 metres wide running from OSGR TF 1072 2535 (A) in a generally easterly direction for approximately 5 metres to OSGR TF 1073 2535 (C) then continuing at 2 metres wide in a generally easterly direction for approximately 58 metres to OSGR TF 1079 2534 (D) then continuing a 2 metres wide in a generally southerly direction for approximately 55 metres to terminate at an unaffected part of Public Footpath 3 at OSGR TF 1078 2529 (B). The total length of footpath added is approximately 118 metres as shown between Points A-C-D-B on annexed Plan No. 2025/019/HacPF3/A4 (27/08/2025).
