

The South Kesteven District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members to Kirkby Underwood Parish Council) Order 2026

1. By virtue of Section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972, where there are so many vacancies in the office of parish councillor that a Parish Council is unable to act, the District Council may by Order appoint persons to fill all or any of the vacancies until other councillors are elected and take up office.
2. Kirkby Underwood Parish Council has four vacancies in the office of Parish Councillor and is unable to act.
3. In pursuance of the power conferred upon it by Section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972, South Kesteven District Council hereby appoints Councillor Nick Robins and County Councillor Martin Hill to act as temporary Members of Kirkby Underwood Parish Council.
4. These temporary appointments will be effective until Kirkby Underwood Parish Council has re-established a quorum by either the co-option or election of two members.
5. When the Parish Council has re-established a quorum these appointments and this Order shall cease.
6. This Order may be cited as The South Kesteven District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members to Kirkby Underwood Parish Council) Order 2026.
7. This Order comes into force on the date upon which it is made.
