- 1.1 Approval of x3 new street names in order to provide postal addresses for a residential development off Main Road Long Bennington REF SNN/2026/0174

2 Comments of Consultees

- 2.1 Long Bennington Parish Council were forwarded the suggestions from the developers for their comments and consideration. There were no objections from the Parish Council.

3 Available Options Considered

- 3.1 This is a development of x50 residential properties off Main Road Long Bennington that requires x3 new road names .
- 3.2 The suggestions of Meadowcroft Drive and Bluebell and Buttercup was given for consideration due to the nature of the site being a meadow with its wild flowers.
- 3.3 The proposed name has been agreed by SKDC and the Parish Council and complies with SKDC's policy and guidance.
