1 The Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 Approval of a new street name in order to provide postal addresses for a residential development off Wellington Way Market Deeping REF SNN/2026/0167

2 Comments of Consultees

- 2.1 The Market Deeping Town Council considered the suggestion for naming by South Kesteven District Council but the members would prefer that the name of Scout be approved, as the relevance of the area and nearby streets were named after aircrafts. Scout was an aircraft that was used in WW1 , also there is a scouts premises in the area.

3 Available Options Considered

- 3.1 This is a development of x11 residential properties off Wellington Way that requires a new road name .
- 3.2 Due to the existing numbering of Wellington Way, it was decided that a new road name would make numbering more logical and easier for emergency services and delivery drivers to locate.
- 3.3 Due to the relevance of the area and nearby streets named after aircrafts, the suggestion of Scout, which was an aircraft used in WW1 and there is a local scout premises was proposed by the Town Council.
- 3.4 The suggestion of Mornington was given by South Kesteven District Council, as this was the 1st Duke of Wellington's mothers name.
- 3.5 The proposed name has been agreed by SKDC and the Parish Council and complies with SKDC's policy and guidance.
