



East Midlands Councils is the consultative forum for all 46 authorities in the region. It provides support to Councils to improve their services and is a strong voice for the East Midlands.

East Midlands Councils will consist of 98 Members:

- 92 Local Authority Members
- 2 Fire and Rescue Authority Members
- 2 Police Authority Members
- 2 Parish and Town Council representatives

East Midlands Leaders Board was formally established in April 2010. It is made up of 14 council leaders, with sufficient authority to act on behalf of all councils in the region. It makes strategic, long-term decisions about housing, transport and the economy and works with the regional development agency, *emda*.
